FOOTBALL AT SKIBBEREEN.

Barryroe had two wides within five minutes, and then Durrus were hard pressed but Barryroe sent wide. A free to Barryroe from midfield, taken by M. Minihane, went wide, and soon afterwards Durrus took the ball down field and scored a point. Durrus had two wides immediately after. Following a great save by Durrus goalie, Barryroe, in a tussle, scored a point. A free to Durrus was well taken by Downing, who scored a goal. On the kick out Durrus again scored a point. Barryroe took the ball up the field, to score a goal per M. Minihane. Durrus had a free from about forty yards, but a great kick by Downing struck the crossbar.

In the second half Barryroe were playing with the sun. Both sides had several unsuccessful frees. From a kick out by Durrus Barryroe sent down field to M. Minihane, who scored a goal. Barryroe were now playing a great game. From a Durrus kick out M. Gallagher took the ball to the other end and scored a goal. A free to Barryroe was sent to Minihane to score a goal, and from a kick out Minihane got a point. Gallagher scored a goal for Durrus a minute later. Just at this stage one of the Barryroe men was knocked out, but resumed later. Durrus secured a goal per M. Gallagher. Durrus had the best of the play at this stage. On the kick out Barryroe rallied down field, and M. Minihane scored a goal. A free being awarded to Durrus, M. Gallagher scored a point. From the kick out Barryroe took the ball to the other end, to score a goal.
