The following is a condensed account of the Revd John Patrickson.

1694. "Mr Patrickson makes frequent journeys to Dublin and stays there - very negligent in his cures."

J. Patrickson, son of John Patrickson, was born in the Co. Down, and when 15 years old entered T.C.D., on 14th Dec. 1666, and obtained a Scholarship in 1667. He was from 1681 to 1717 Presentor of Ross and Vicar of Kilmaccabee and Kilfaughnabeg, and from 1683 to 1717 Rector of Caheragh, from 1683 to 1694 Vicar of Glanbarrahan, and from 1683 to 1692 Vicar of Tullagh and Creagh; from 1683 to 1685 Rector of Tullagh and Creagh; from 1684 to 1685 P.Vicar of Holy Trinity Cork; from 1685 to 1717 Precentor of Cloyne, and from 1695 to 1717 Vicar of Kinneigh and Fanlobbus (Dunmanway).

He died in 1717. He married Elizabeth, daughter of Robert Phaire and had issue Thomas, Margaret, Martha and Frances. His daughter Frances married (1) Onesiphorus Phaire Esq of Templeshannon, Co Wexford, and (2) William Henderson Esq.
