Lease of 18 May 1730, whereby William Blair of Dunmanway Esq sold to Robert Goold of Dunmanway in the Co Cork, part of the lands of Kilbarry in the Barony of East Carbery, for 68 years, at £30 per annum.

Lease and Release of 29 and 30 October 1731, between (1) William Blair of Dunmanway, and (2) the Earl of Cork.

Reciting that Onosiphorus Gamble of Maryborough in the county of the city of Cork gent, administrator of the Revd John Patrickson in Trust for Frances Henderson alias Patrickson, Margaret, Thomas and Martha Patrickson, children of the said Dr Patrickson, by Indenture dated 18 December 1723 demised to Richard White of Whiddy Island gent the lands of Kilbarry, Teneford, Coolusneaghtuboom, Shinlogh, Inchiereigh, Derenacaharah, Clentink, Derinasavagh and Gortnarea in the Barony of East Carbery.

Reciting that said Richard White had assigned his interest in same unto (1).

Reciting that (1) had entered into a Bond for £3,477-1-0 for payment of £1,738-10-6 on 25th March next.

Whereby (1) conveys said lands to (2) as security for same.
