Post 1755		Robert Trenwith		TWO RENTAL LEDGERS OF RICHARD WHITE (GRANDFATHER OF THE FIRST EARL): First rental ledger: Robert Trinwith "has leased for 31 years from 25th March 1755" The yearly rent was 40.7.6, but Richard White writes "I promise to allow you half years rent from Glanlough & Caha in consideration of your giving them up to Delany at Lady Day 1756" The yearly rent due from then on is 31.5.0. Written on the margin is "from L Day 1756 is to pay 31.5.0" and "is to grease one collop yearly". Second rental ledger lists more details of the lands leased by Richard White to Robert Trinwith. They include Dromagolane & Dromshane, Kiltrashna, Cillana, Dromilogh, Curraduff, Garryglass, Leitrim, and Wolusker.	Written in the margins by White is the following comment: "Trinwith is to grease one collop yearly-He and his sons & sons-in-law deserved no favors from me they all being great Partisans of the Hutchinsons Huthcins & all other Enemys to my interest". Also written in the margins is "Note from Michl' 1765, these lands are given up to my son." Emer indicates the spelling of townland names has probably changed and that she believes a Collop to be a young cow or heifer. Lady's Day is 25 March. Michaelmas is 29, Sept. Grease=graze.
