Son John ended up in New York whilst Thomas and Lucinda spent some time in Wales before migrating to Chile around 1853.	Richard Trewhela was a blacksmith in the Allihies Mines and when he died in 1839 was recorded as 'head smith of Allihies Mines'. He and his family left Cornwall sometime between 1826 and about 1830. Two more sons were born after arrival probably at Killeconenagh or Berehaven. After Richard's death in 1839 most of the family seemed to move on.
